LIGHT MULES

Size: To be of good size compatible with that of the parents.

Shape: To be of stout cone shape, with broad bold head, and close-fitting wings and tail.

Colour: To be deep and rich in colour naturally and when colour fed to be considerably intensified.

Markings: To be distinctly characteristic of both parents, and the clearer the plumage the better.

Quality: The plumage to exhibit the highest possible smooth glossy surface throughout

Condition: To be sound in condition in every part.

Steadiness: The bolder and firmer the stand on the perch the better.

Staging: To be shown in clean condition and a clean cage.
